



2018 - 2019 DAPP Scholars Program Requirements and Expectations

The following is a list of expectations and requirements for students participating in the Diverse Attorney Pipeline Program Scholars Program during the 2018-2019 academic year:

1. Attend all law school classes pursuant to each professor's attendance policy.
2. Miss no more than one (1) regularly-scheduled DAPP Session during each semester.
3. Maintain a 3.0 GPA in order to be eligible to participate in DAPP Direct, job placement opportunities and remain in good standing.
4. Attend your professors' office hours each week.
5. Tender a weekly status report (oral or in writing) to your DAPP 3L Director.
6. Take drafts of all writing assignments that will be graded to your writing resource center, teacher's assistant, or equivalent within three (3) days of your writing assignment due date.
7. Tender the results of all assignments, quizzes, mid-term and final examinations (both graded and ungraded) to the Program Director once receive.
8. Tender an unofficial transcript at the end of first and second semester to the Program Director.
9. Maintain respectful correspondence with any organization, company, entity or person when conducting business related to DAPP or representing the program.
10. Report directly to your DAPP 3L Director and the Program Director if you require any assistance with classes or have any difficulty complying with the Program's requirements and expectations.
11. Respond to all requests and inquiries from DAPP leadership within 24 hours.
12. Participate in surveys or other data gathering initiatives throughout the DAPP program and exit surveys immediately after completion of the DAPP program.
13. Speak at DAPP events about the DAPP program and how the program has been beneficial to your academic and professional legal career.
14. As a DAPP alumni, write 1 – 2 testimonials to be used in promotional materials, serve on the associate board and/or encourage your employer to support DAPP.
